- **Text**: A Second Course in Statistics: Regression Analysis (6th edition), W. MendenHall and T. Sincich
- **Computing**: The JMP (version 8) is the required statistical package. The Statistics Department was able to work out a special arrangement with SAS. Our students can now get a 3 year license for JMP8 by paying only \$10 more than the price of a 6-month license. - **Course Description** This is a second course in statistics and data analysis. We will focus on the general linear model (regression and analysis of variance) with some discussion of logistic regression if there is time (at least chapters 1-8 in the text).
