Course Description: This practically oriented course examines the critical legal issues confronting start-ups with a focus on innovation and disruption. Cutting edge topics include the new drone law, which permits companies to benefit from the efficiency of aerial view techniques. Students will learn to use the law to manage risk, deploy resources and maximize value by analyzing cases, statutes, pleadings and contracts. The course covers the entire lifecycle of a business and deals with cybersecurity and privacy, confidentiality, noncompetition and invention assignment clauses, tax advantages of limited liability companies (LLC) v. corporations or partnerships, securities law strategy for raising venture capital, independent contractor v. employee concerns, discrimination laws, merger and acquisition exit plans, intellectual property (IP) including patents, trade secrets, copyrights and trademarks, as well as restructuring and bankruptcy. Students will emerge with the skills to spot legal issues, know when to call a lawyer, draft term sheets, and manage risk/litigation.
