Course Overview

This course is designed to provide a basic introduction to financial accounting with the goal of preparing you for the full semester courses ACCT611 and ACCT 613. The course is intended for students with <u>no</u> previous exposure to financial accounting. We will cover the balance sheet and the income statement, focusing on the definition and measurement of assets, liabilities, stockholder's equity, revenues, and expenses. The course will also introduce you to the fundamentals of bookkeeping, including debits and credits, journal entries, and T-accounts. Finally, we will go through an entire accounting cycle, starting with recording simple transactions and ending with financial statement preparation.
